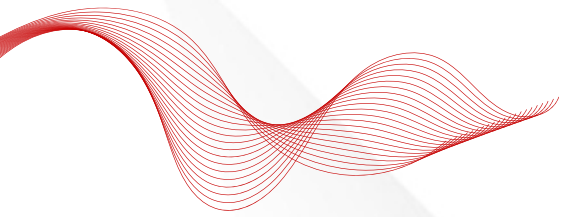

Strategic Observations on Optionals

- Mathematics & Electrical Engineering top the optional averages — scoring 300+ is feasible with structured practice.
- Anthropology remains the most popular optional with 30+ candidates — highly competitive but consistent.
- Sociology averages around 260 — a solid performer with vast coaching support and answer resources.
- Pol. Science & IR has the highest number of selects — but average optional score is moderate (~268).
- Niche subjects like Geology, Psychology, and Zoology show high averages due to fewer but well-prepared candidates.
- History and Economics offer consistent mid-range scores (~265–270) with predictable question patterns.

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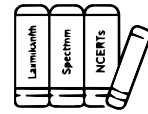
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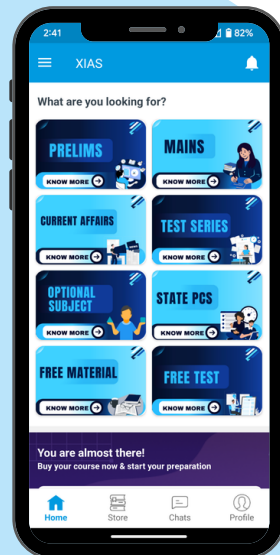


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
